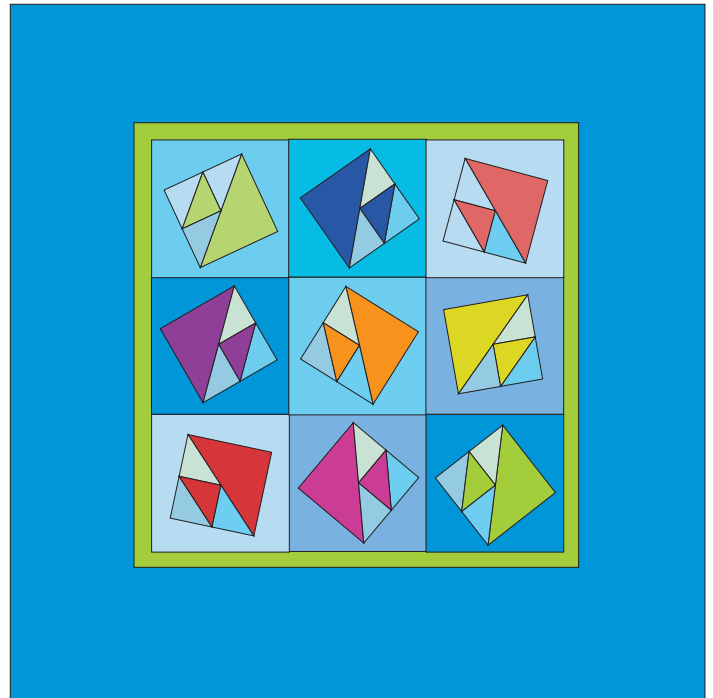
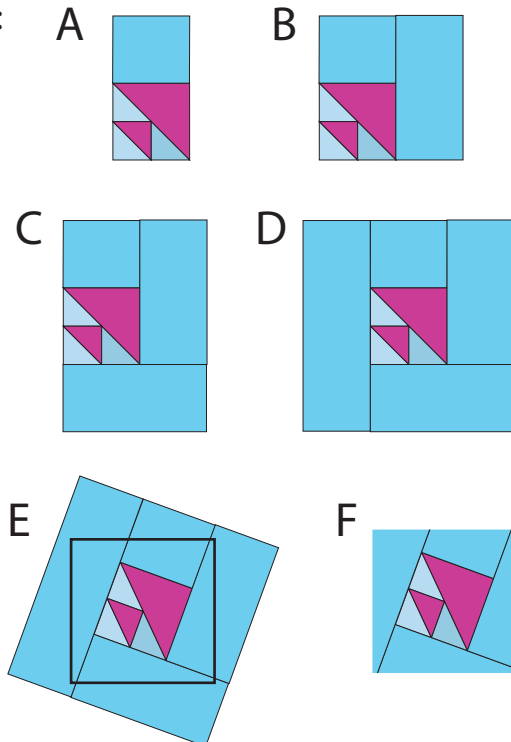


# TROPICAL FISH

1. Copy and print the attached foundations to make these playful tropical fish.
2. Stitch the foundation blocks (based on one part from the 4" spool in the Little Bits pattern - V227 Scrap Happy Spools).
3. Add a 2" strip to each side of the fish block. As you add the strips, trim each of them to fit the block as shown in diagrams A, B, C and D.
4. Use a rotary ruler to measure and trim the blocks to  $3\frac{3}{4}$ ". To add interest to your quilt, rotate the fish to a variety of angles as you trim them to size (diagrams E and F).
5. Sew blocks together into rows, and then sew the rows together to complete the center of the quilt top.
6. Add an inner border, trimming the strips to size as you add them. The illustrated inner border is made using 1" strips.
7. Add an outer border, trimming the strips to size as you add them. The illustrated outer border is made using 5" strips.
8. Layer the quilt top with backing and batting and quilt the three layers together.
9. Add binding to complete the project.

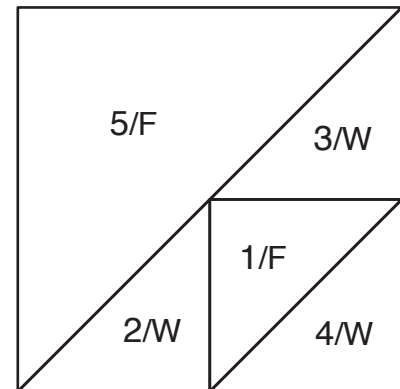

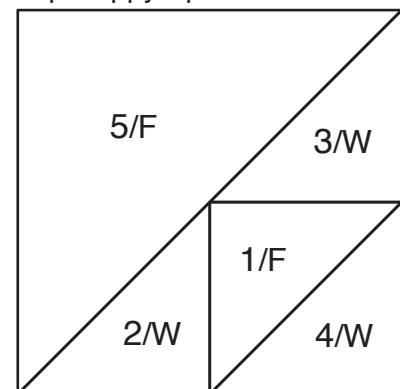
F = fish    W = water
